1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 29.11.2023 passed in CWP-26262-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Navdeep Singh, Joint Director, Administration, Department of General Higher Education, Haryana, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 29.11.2023 passed in CWP-26262-2023 has since been complied with and necessary payments have been made to the petitioners.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioners is left unredressed, they would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
