This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr. PC seeking direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to decide the complaints dated 15.11.2023 and 20.03.2024 (Annexures P-1 to P-3) and to pass the appropriate orders in accordance with the law.

2. Heard.

3. It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that feeling aggrieved by the acts and conduct of the private respondents No. 5 to 9, the petitioner had moved to the authorities number of times and had even moved representations, the latest being Annexure P-3 dated 20.03.2024, but the same is still pending decision.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the for the purpose of the present petition, the petitioner will be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No. 3 to consider and dispose of the aforesaid representation in accordance with the law in an expeditious manner.

5. Notice of motion to the official respondents.

6. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Surender Singh, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that the aforesaid representation will be decided expeditiously in accordance with the law.

7. In the circumstances of the case and without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No. 3-Superintendent of Police, Kaithal, to consider the averments made in the representation dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-3), to dispose of the same expeditiously and to take action, as warranted, under the provisions of the law.

8. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner.
