1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the orders dated 10.12.2018 passed in CWP-25782-2018, dated 24.03.2023 passed in LPA-1199-2019 and dated 31.01.2024 passed in Civil Appeal No.6395-2023.
2. Counsel for the respondents submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid orders, the petitioner has been offered appointment for the post of Post Graduate Teacher, Political Science (HES-II), (Rest of Haryana Cadre) against Advt. No.4/2015. Copy of the necessary dated 12.07.2024, produced by the counsel for the respondents in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
