1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRWP-162-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Court today, is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CRWP-162-2023 has since been complied with and necessary order dated 25.06.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed after considering the application of the petitioner for pre-mature release.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
