**PANKAJ JAIN, J. (Oral)**

1. Prayer is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.206 dated 14.12.2023 registered for offences punishable under Section 379-B of IPC (Sections 411 and 201 of IPC added lateron) at Police Station Cantonment, District Police Commissionerate, Amritsar.

2. As per the contents of the FIR, it has been alleged as under:-

*“Statement of complainant Harish Kumar son of Hari Shankar, resident of Naseerabad, Police Station Naseerabad, District Rai Bareli, State Uttar Pradesh, now resident of tenant Sector No. 01, Ranjit Vihar, Near Holy Heart School, Amritsar, aged about 25 years, Mobile No. 60365-94905 stated that I am resident of above mentioned address. I am doing the work of ironing near park in Sector 01, Ranjit Vihar which is situated near to my house. On dated 13.12.2023 time about 5.15 PM, I was ironing clothes on my handcart. One Honda City white colour car came near my handcart. One person who was wearing cap alighted from car and started*

*giving me slap blows and asked me to handover whatever I was having. He snatched my purse which was containing Rs. 3800/- and my Realme Mobile Phone having Sim No. 95547-10079 VI company and Sim No. 98142-95104 VI company. I could read his car number. At that time my brother was not at home. My brother told that we will lodge complaint tomorrow. Today I alongwith my brother Aseem Kumar came to you for informing the incident. Legal action be taken. Sd/ Harish Kumar aforesaid, verified by Tejinder Singh ASI, Police Post Guntala Bypass Police Station Cantonment Amritsar.”*

3. Counsel for the petitioner relies upon document Annexure P-2 to submit that petitioner as well as complainant has compromised the matter. Challan already stands presented.

4. Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the present case, present petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

5. Needless to say that anything observed herein shall not be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case.
