SUMEET GOEL, J. (Oral)

1. The instant petition has been filed with the following substantial prayer:

“It is further submitted that FIR No.108 dated 14.11.2015 at P.S. Kathunangal u/s 376, 506 IPC, and all the consequential proceedings on the basis of compromise/affidavits submitted by the respondent No.2 and her parents in favour of petitioner, may kindly be quashed, in the interest of justice”

2. Mr. Rishab Goyal, Advocate has appeared and filed memorandum of appearance on behalf of respondent No.2 and vakalatnama on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4 respectively. The same are taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for respondents No.2 to 4 has stated that a compromise has in fact been arrived at between the parties.

4. A perusal of the reply dated 28.05.2024 filed on behalf of State of Punjab reveals as follows:



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“8. That the aforesaid report submitted by then Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Majitha, Amritsar (Rural) has been approved by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) on 05.02.2024 and it has been submitted in the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar on 29.02.2024.

9. That it humbly submitted that the deponent has apprised the Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar (Rural) with respect to the negligence committed by the concerned investigating officers, who remained posted at Police Post Jaintipur, Police Station Kathunangal, Amritsar (Rural) from 07.12.2015 to 05.01.2024 with a recommendation to initiate disciplinary action against them for causing delay in the completion of the investigation.

10. That the Cancellation Report (UCR No.68 of 2024) has been submitted in the Court of Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar on 29.02.2024. The Ld. Judicial Magistrate First Class, Amritsar has issued notice to the respondent No.2 for 13.06.2024.”

- 5. Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition at this stage.
- 6. Ordered accordingly.
- 7. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed off.
