1. On 23.10.2024, the following order was passed:-

“The short issue involved in the present petition is that the passport of the petitioner (minor child) has not been issued as the consent of her father is not available.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parents of the petitioner are in a matrimonial dispute and, hence, the father is not giving the consent. However, this court is of the view that the father of the petitioner has not been made a party in the present petition.

Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to make her father as a party-respondent so that appropriate notice could be issued to him and in case he fails to response to the notice issued by this Court, appropriate directions will be issued to the authorities.

Needful be done before the next date of hearing.

Adjourned to 25.11.2024.”

2. The learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that the



petitioner's mother has visited the office of local Regional Passport Office, Jalandhar and furnished affidavit in the form of Annexure-G.

3. The learned counsel representing the respondents submits that the Regional Passport Officer shall take an appropriate decision in accordance with law within a period of next 10 days, from today.

4. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of.

5. However, the petitioner shall have the liberty to revisit the court if the grievance is not redressed.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
