The instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.915 dated 22.11.2022, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 409 and 120-B of the IPC, 1860 and Section 7/13 of PC Act, registered at Police Station City Panipat, District Panipat.

This Court vide order dated 08.04.2024, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 08.04.2024, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parmod Kumar, does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.
