This petition has been filed seeking regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 20 dated 19.02.2023 under Sections 21(C)/25/29 of The Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at P.S. Jhabal, District Tarn Taran.

A request for hearing of the case through Video Conferencing was made on behalf of the petitioner but none has joined the VC.

Initially application for interim bail was preferred on account of certain ceremonies to be performed for newly born baby of the petitioner which was dismissed as rendered infructuous. Subsequently, on 19.04.2024, counsel for the petitioner moved another application for interim bail on the same cause of action without any change in circumstances. That application found to be malicious with frivolous grounds that is to perform ceremonies and rituals on account of



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newly born baby who took birth on 10.10.2023 and there was no pending ceremony at that time, accordingly the application was dismissed with cost of Rs. 10000/- to be deposited with Punjab and Haryana High Court Bar Clerk Association, Chandigarh.

In pursuance to order dated 19.04.2024, cost has been deposited and the receipt is taken on record.

Today, the case has been called but none has come present on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that counsel is not interested in pursuing the main petition, consequently, the same is dismissed for non-prosecution.
