Learned State counsel has informed this Court that Office of the Regional Transport Officer, Jalandhar has re-examined the case of the petitioner and found that on account of discrepancies in the original record and the online record, the demand had been raised which has been now modified and it has been directed now that the school bus in question is required to pay Rs.20,000/- per annum as tax. The above noted Educational Society has already deposited the said amount upto 30.09.2024 and is not required to deposit any more amount in lieu of tax for the said period.

2. In view thereof, the order dated 24.09.2024 as above, is taken on record.

3. Keeping in view thereto, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, submits that he does not further press this petition.

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4. In view of above, giving quietus to the issue, writ petition is disposed of as not pressed.
