KARAMJIT SINGH, J. (Oral)

Counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* submits that the petitioner is an NRI and is also OCI Card holder and is permanent resident of England but presently, is on visit to India and is aged about 82 years. It is further submitted that the petitioner has rented out his shops to some third person and respondent No.4 is his neighbour and intends to usurp the immovable property of the petitioner including his shops. Counsel for the petitioner further submits that respondent NO.4 is in the habit of giving false complaints against the petitioner and to one such complaint, the petitioner has submitted reply (Annexure P-14). Counsel for the petitioner further submits that respondent No.4 is also extending threats to cause harm to person and property of the petitioner.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. J.S.Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that as per his instructions, at present, no such

representation filed by the petitioner is pending before the police authorities.

4. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner submits that necessary direction be given to respondent No.2 to look into the matter and to take decision in a time bound manner if in future, any representation is filed by the petitioner, in this regard.
