JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of selection order (Annexure P-2) whereby Petrol Pump has been allotted to respondent No. 4.
2. The petitioner online applied for the allotment of Petrol Pump in Group-A. There were two candidates in said category. The application of the petitioner before draw of lots was withdrawn. Accordingly, second candidate came to be selected.
3. Mr. Ashok Verma, Advocate claims that petitioner did not withdraw his application and someone else had played foul.
4. Notice of motion.
5. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who on advance notice is present in Court, accepts notice and waives service.

The allegations made by petitioner are factual in nature. These allegations need to be investigated by some agency. This Court in exercise of its writ jurisdiction cannot return findings on disputed questions of fact.

The petition stands disposed of with liberty to petitioner to avail remedy as permissible by law.
