Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is entitled for regularization of his services, which benefit is not being granted to him for which the petitioner is entitled for, especially, keeping in view the order passed by this Court in **CWP-6993-2021 Satish Kumar vs. State of Haryana and others and other connected case, decided on 13.03.2024.**

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that respondents have passed order dated 26.04.2019 (Annexure P/7) and thereafter, the petitioner has approached the respondents by way of serving legal notice dated 30.05.2023 (Annexure P/10), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice.

Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case legal notice dated 30.05.2023 (Annexure P/10) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the respondents, the same will be decided by the respondents in accordance with law and an appropriate order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
