AWARD OF LOK ADALAT BENCH NO.4

As agreed, (statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded) a sum of Rs.7,75,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount will be paid equally to the LR's of the appellant namely Ravi Kumar, Raman Kumar and Amit Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed cheques in the sum of Rs.7,75,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs Seventy Five Thousand Only) in the names of Ravi Kumar, Raman Kumar and Amit Kumar, LR's of the appellant-Bimla Devi in equal share, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 28.06.2024. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

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Appeal stands disposed of.
