Prayer in the present petition is for setting aside the order dated 20.03.2024 (Annexure P-13) passed by learned Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Camp, Nuh, whereby the application for stay filed by the petitioner has been dismissed. Further prayer has been made for staying the operation of the order dated 26.10.2023 (Annexure P-9) and for staying the dispossession of the petitioner from the property in question.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that appeal is pending for final adjudication on 24.04.2024 before respondent No.2. He has further submitted that stay application has been decided and execution application is also filed, which is fixed for hearing today itself.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Upasana Dhawan, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Mr. Ghulam Nabi Malik, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4. He has submitted that appeal is fixed for final hearing and the same would be argued on the date fixed.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 i.e. the Commissioner, Faridabad Division, Camp,

Nuh to decide the appeal after hearing both the sides expeditiously preferably within 15 days from 24.04.2024 i.e. the date fixed before him. No coercive action shall be taken against the petitioner till the decision of the appeal by respondent No.2.
