1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for fair and impartial investigation/further investigation in case FIR No.08 dated 02.02.2016, under Sections 498-A, 406 and 420 IPC, registered at Police Station Women, Amritsar City (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned State counsel has informed that investigation is complete. Final report/challan under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed before the trial court against petitioner-Nirmal Singh.
