The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner which is under imminent danger at the hands of private respondents who can cause bodily harm to the petitioner.

After arguing for some time, once the learned counsel for the petitioner fails to establish any cause of action in the instant petition, he prays for withdrawal of the same with liberty to approach the appropriate forum of law in accordance with law.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.
