1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioners for re-appointment for the post of Safai Sewak/Sewarmen as they were appointed for the abovesaid posts vide letters dated 06.01.2022 (Annexure P-1 and P-2), however, due to their personal difficulties (their mother was seriously ill), they had given resignation as no leave was approved by respondent No.3.

2. After arguing the case for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to pursue the matter with the department.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
