1. Learned counsel for the petitioner after arguing at length, when this Court was not inclined to grant the relief of regular bail, seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the instant petition. However, submitted that a direction be passed upon the learned trial Court concerned to expedite the trial as the petitioner has suffered incarceration of about 02 years 06 months as on today and till date only 11 out of 24 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

The Superintendent of Police concerned is also directed to ensure that all the prosecution witnesses as and when called upon by the learned trial Court shall remain present for their examination.
