Learned State counsel apprised the Court that two gunmen are already provided to the petitioner by the police, after assessing his threat perception.

2. Faced with this situation, counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submits that the petitioner is a liquor vendor and he is receiving threats from known gangsters who are operating in the Northern India and in this regard, the petitioner has already moved representation (Annexure P-12).

Counsel for the petitioner further submits that he will be satisfied if necessary direction is given to the competent authority i.e. respondent No.2 to look into the matter and do the needful after assessing afresh threat perception which is their to the petitioner from the side of the known gangsters of the area.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any such representation is pending, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same, in accordance with law.

In light of the above and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the present petition is hereby disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation (Annexure P-12) of the petitioner, in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
