By way of this petition filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C., petitioner, who is complainant of FIR No.0006 dated 06.01.2023, under Section 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Dayalpura, District Bathinda, has prayed for cancellation of anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 vide order dated 22.03.2023 (Annexure P-7) by learned Addl. Sessions Judge, Bathinda.

2. The dispute has arisen out of the matrimonial discord between the petitioner and his wife. Respondent No.2 is the father-in-law of the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length, but he could not convince this Court regarding any ground on which the anticipatory bail granted to respondent No.2 is liable to be cancelled.
