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**VINOD S. BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)**

The petitioner has approached this Court for seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.5 i.e. Superintending Engineer, Commercial, Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Limited, to take appropriate step/action on the letter/Memo No.5595 dated 23.01.2023 (Annexure P-9) and to grant concessional rates in the tariff for the financial year 2022-2023 as per the Sale Circular No.D-30/2022 dated 14.11.2022.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent Distribution Licensee has shown to this Court a copy of the Memo No.1902 dated 23.07.2024 as per which the respondents-Distribution Licensee have conveyed that the tariff concession of Rs.11,70,000/- has been adjusted in the bill of the petitioner in the month of July 2023 under Sale Circular No.D-30/2022 dated 14.11.2022. He undertakes to supply a copy of the said communication along with all the details of the bill adjustment to the counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that he needs to confirm the same, however, considering that the aforesaid statement has been made on behalf of the respondent Distribution Licensee on receipt of a communication from them, I find that no purpose would be served by keeping the present petition pending.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

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Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to seek revival of the present writ petition in case the benefit as stated to have been released in favour of the petitioner has actually not been disbursed.
