Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, a girl aged about 20 years seeking direction to respondents No.1 and 2 to provide protection to her from the hands of her parents who are respondents No.3 and 4.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner left her parental house as the parents intend to perform her marriage against her wishes and now respondents No.3 and 4 are extending threats to the petitioner and in this regard, representation (Annexure P-2) was given to respondent No.2 but the police authorities failed to take any action.

3. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a time bound direction is given to the official respondents to consider and decide representation dated 5.4.2024 (Annexure P-2).

4. Notice of motion.

5. Mr. Vishal Kashyap, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submitted that the parents have already lodged FIR under

Section 346 IPC with regard to missing of their daughter i.e. the petitioner. State counsel submits that in case any complaint/representation(s) has been filed, the concerned authorities will consider and decide the same as per law.

6. In view of above and without going into the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation dated 5.4.2024 (Annexure P-2) in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
