The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 439 of Cr.P.C with a prayer to grant the concession of regular bail to him in case arising out of FIR No.66, dated 13.06.2018, under Sections 452,324,323,148,149 of IPC (326 of IPC added later on and Section 452 of IPC substituted with Section 450 of IPC later on) Police Station Sadar Faridkot, District Faridkot (Annexure P-1).

The Registry of the Court had raised objections on 23.06.2020, however, no learned counsel had collected the paperbook for removal of the objections. It seems that the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the present petition.

3. Consequently, the petition is ordered to be dismissed.
