This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to ensure protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members at the hands of respondents No.5 to 11 and to conduct fair and impartial enquiry into the complaint dated 07.12.2018 (Annexure P8) and register criminal case against the said private respondents.

During the course of hearing and after having examined the case file and on a query put to learned counsel for the petitioner, after a lapse of 4 years since the filing of the petition, the petitioner is living at the address without any fear or threat. As such, there seems to be no imminent danger or threat to the life of the petitioner.
