1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondent to appoint the petitioner as Conductor from the date when other persons mentioned in order dated 06.08.1998 were appointed and to grant all consequential benefits to him.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts he has not been able to get further instructions from the petitioner.
3. In this view of the matter, the instant petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
