1. The petitioner has filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to absorb the petitioners in Boards/Corporations/Cooperative Institutions and other Departments of the Government of Punjab, whereby the posts are lying vacant.
2. On 12.09.2022, learned counsel for the petitioner sought time to implead the official liquidator and on 10.01.2024, he sought last opportunity for doing the same. However, official liquidator has not been impleaded.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to contact the petitioners to further pursue the matter.
4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
