HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 25.01.2019 (Annexure P-1), the petitioner was transferred as Incharge, Territorial Range, Ballabgarh on which post the petitioner was working and without there being any order of the competent authority, vide order dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-4), the petitioner has been posted at P.C. Branch Incharge, which is arbitrary and illegal and beyond the power of Deputy Conservator of Forests, Faridabad as only the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is the competent authority to pass appropriate order.

2. Notice of motion.

3. Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that keeping in

view the letter written by the Deputy Conservator Forests, Faridabad to the competent authority dated 01.04.2024, an order has already been passed by the competent authority transferring the petitioner to P.C. Branch Incharge and the order dated 03.04.2024 (Annexure P-4) is only the implementation of the order dated 01.04.2024 passed by the competent authority and the order dated 01.04.2024 passed by the competent authority is not under challenge.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no order of the competent authority dated 01.04.2024 has been supplied to him and keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to challenge the appropriate order in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the said order in any manner.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. Let the copy of the order dated 01.04.2024 passed by the Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests be supplied to the petitioner during the course of the day by the learned counsel for the respondents, if not already supplied.
