RAJ KUMAR VS. STATE OF HARYANA AND ORS.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant and Mr. Sulinder Kumar, DAG Haryana alongwith Mr. Navneet Singh, GM, Sirsa for respondent Nos.1 to 4 (separately recorded), a sum of ₹25,000/- (₹ Twenty five Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant- Raj Kumar.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹25,000/- in the name of appellant- Raj Kumar, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 16.04.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
