1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned order Annexure P-11/T, whereby the sanction of respondent No.1 (Annexure P-4/T) to the approved resolution (Annexure P-2/T) for upgradation of two posts of Deputy General Manager which had been created after abolishing two posts of District Mandi Officers, stands withdrawn by respondent No.1.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that during the pendency of the present petition, petitioners have been further promoted to the post of General Manager from the post of Deputy General Manager and have since retired from service and with the efflux of time, instant petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Disposed of as having become infructuous.
