1. Learned State counsel submits that in the reply filed by the respondents it has been stated that the State Government had initially allowed ‘5’ marks to be granted as per the transfer policy only to females in couple cases and thereafter this Court vide interim order dated 17.04.2023, directed that award of ‘5’ marks would also be applicable to the male employees in couple cases.
2. Keeping in view thereto, the State Government has taken a decision and implemented the interim order passed by this Court for the last year as well as for this year and now under the policy ‘5’ marks shall be allotted to both females as well as males in couple cases in terms of the transfer policy.
3. In view of the grievance of the petitioner having redressed

substantially, no further order is required to be passed in this writ petition. The writ petition is accordingly disposed of in terms of the statement of learned counsel for the State. The interim order passed by this Court earlier shall accordingly stands vacated.

4. All pending misc. application(s) also stand disposed of.
