A perusal of the zimni orders would show that the prosecution evidence stood concluded on 24.02.2023 on which date the statements of the accused were recorded under Section 313 Cr.P.C. Despite a period of more than one year has elapsed, the Trial has not concluded.

In view of the fact that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than three and a half years, the Trial Court is directed to conclude the Trial as expeditiously as possible but in any case, not later than 02 months from the next date of hearing fixed before it.
