1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CWP-16189-2014.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of Anurag Verma, IAS, Chief Secretary, Punjab, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 10.01.2023 passed in CWP-16189-2014 has been complied with and necessary promotion order has been issued, as would decipher from the order dated 09.07.2024 (Annexure R-1).
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
