1. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the petitioner is working as conductor with the respondent-department but his salary for the period starting from May, 2023 till 04.01.2024 has not been released by the respondents, which action on the part of the respondents is arbitrary and illegal. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that once, the petitioner had discharged the duties for the period in question, the respondents are under an obligation to release the salary for the said period.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the grievance raised in the present petition has already been raised by the petitioner by way of submitting the representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-4) and the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said representation.

4. Mr. Harish Nain, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.
5. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case representation dated 04.03.2024 (Annexure P-4) has been received from the petitioner and is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided in accordance with law and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order and in case it is found feasible to grant the relief to the petitioner, the same will be extended to him otherwise, due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner, which will be conveyed to the petitioner.
6. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of the learned counsel for the respondents, present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
