1. The petitioners have filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India with a prayer to direct the respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners,as they apprehend threat at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.
2. Learned State counsel submits that in the present case one FIR No. 28 dated 24.02.2024, under Sections 363,366 of IPC, Police Station Ghumeen, has already been registered against petitioner No.1. He further contends that the police is raiding the premises of petitioner No.1 and after arresting the petitioner No.1, the investigation shall be taken to its logical end.
4. In view of the statement made by learned State counsel, no further directions are required and the petition is accordingly, dismissed.
