NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The petitioners have filed the instant writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to release all the service benefits accrued to the deceased father of the petitioners along with interest @ 24% per annum.
2. Learned counsel for respondent No.3, on instructions from Sh. Gurtej Singh, Secretary, Government Agricultural Co-operative Society Limited, submits that all the dues shall be released to the petitioners, within a period of two months in three installments.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for respondent No.3, the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous and disposed of accordingly.
4. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners to revive the present petition, if there is any non-compliance of the undertaking made in the Court.
