1. At the outset, counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner stand acquitted. Petitioner challenged impugned order dated 15.01.2016 whereby he was declared ‘proclaimed offender’. After the petitioner was directed to appear before Trial Court, the petitioner complied with the order and now stands acquitted.
2. In view of this, since P.O. proceedings are a measure to secure the presence of accused, this Court finds that the impugned order has lost its sting and relevance. In view thereof, no further order is warranted.
3. Disposed off, accordingly.
