1. Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No.26 dated 05.03.2024 registered under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Division No.4, District Patiala.
