[1] Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.215, dated 14.08.2006, registered under Sections 307, 323, 341, 506, 120-B, 148, 149 IPC, at Police Station Division No.4, Jalandhar, and all subsequent proceedings arising out of the registration of the FIR including order dated 11.03.2013 passed by the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar.

[2] Status report by way of affidavit dated 08.11.2023 of Shri Nirmal Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Jalandhar, on behalf of respondent No.1-State has been filed in Court today. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to counsel opposite. Para Nos.3 to 6 of which are relevant, reads as under:-

“3. That after registration of FIR, petitioner had moved application before then SSP Jalandhar for conducting re-investigation in the present case and said application was entrusted to then DSP City-1, Jalandhar and after inquiry vide his report dated 14.8.2006 he recommended to file cancellation report in the present case and forwarded his report to then SSP Jalandhar.

4. That after taking opinion from DA legal, SSP Jalandhar has recommended to file cancellation report in the present case.
5. That thereafter SHO PS Div. No.4, Jalandhar prepared cancellation report and same was presented before ld. Court of CJM, Jalandhar on 3.11.2012, however same was returned by said Court vide order dated 11.3.2013 for reinvestigation in the present case.
6. That on last date of hearing i.e. 17.08.2023 this Hon’ble Court was pleased to direct answering respondent to file cancellation report in the present case and same was presented before the Court of Ld. CJM, Jalandhar on 7.11.2023 and same is pending before said Court. ”

[3] In view of the aforesaid status report, nothing else is required to be done by this Court. As such, this petition is hereby disposed of. It is made clear that in case, cancellation report is not accepted, the petitioner will be at liberty to avail the remedies available to him, in accordance with law.
