1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 2, 11 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 03.11.2023 passed in CWP-24404-2023.
2. Compliance report by way of affidavit of the respondent, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 03.11.2023 passed in CWP-24404-2023 has been complied with and speaking order dated 10.07.2024 (Annexure R-1) has been passed after granting opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
