Present writ petition has been under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to correct the date of birth of the petitioner in his Matriculation Certificate dated 01.06.2011 (Annexure P-1) on the basis of Birth Certificate, Passport and Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2).
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that inadvertently, the rejection order dated 16.08.2023 (Annexure P-6) has not been challenged by the petitioner and thus, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after laying challenge to the same.
3. In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
