The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.16 dated 13.01.2024 under Sections 120-B, 406, 407, 409 and 420 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar, Mohindergarh (Haryana).

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 10.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from SI Hari Parkash submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 10.04.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 10.04.2024 is made absolute.



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However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
