1. The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to
respondent No.2-SSP Jalandhar (Rural) to proceed against private
respondents No.7 to 9 in accordance with law, submitting further that
the official respondents No.4 and 5 are hand in glove with the private



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respondents.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to the official respondents to look into representation (Annexure P-6) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in the light of ***Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.***

3. In the wake of the limited prayer of the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of and respondent No.2 i.e. SSP, Jalandhar (Rural), is directed to look into the representation of the petitioner (Annexure P-6) at the earliest, decide the same within four weeks from today and take appropriate steps, if any required, under the provisions of law. However, if respondent No.2 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation (Annexure P-6), then the petitioner shall be duly informed as per the parameters laid down by the Supreme Court in ***Lalita Kumari v. Government of Uttar Pradesh & Ors. : 2013 (4) RCR (Criminal) 979.***
