HARKESH MANUJA, J.(ORAL)

1. By way of present petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, prayer has been made for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for willful non-compliance of the Order dated 31.10.2022 passed by this Court in CWP-1561-2014 (Annexure P-1).
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that petitioner has been accorded benefits of Selection Grade as well as Senior Scale along with the benefits of Pay Band-4 and arrears after refixation of his pay shall be released in his favour within a period of one week from today.
3. In view of the aforesaid undertaking, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage and submits that the same be disposed of with liberty to revive the same in case needful is not done.
4. Ordered accordingly.
5. However, in case the needful is not done within the aforementioned period, as per the undertaking, the petitioner would be at



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liberty to seek revival of the contempt petition and in that eventuality, the respondent would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.

6. Rule stands discharged.
