Mr. Rehan Gupta, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the LRs of the appellant and filed his Power of Attorney. The same is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellant, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.1,75,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Seventy Five Thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

One of the legal heirs of the appellant, namely, Somwati has given a statement before this Forum that her husband Naresh Kumar has since expired on 07.11.2006. The death certificate is being taken on record. She further states that there are three legal heirs i.e. herself and her sons namely, Shree Narayana and Onkar and there are no other legal heirs except them. They are ordered to be brought on record as legal heirs. The amended memo of parties is filed. As per instructions from his clients, learned counsel for the appellants states that the enhanced amount would be paid to Somwati.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.1,75,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Seventy Five Thousand only) in the name of Somwati with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 03.07.2024 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
