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**RAJBIR SEHRAWAT, J. (Oral)**

1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India, for punishing the respondents for disobeying the order dated 22.01.2019 passed in CWP-7072-2018.
2. Compliance affidavit of Rajesh Kumar Sood, Under Secretary/HR-1, UHBVNL, Panchkula, filed in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the respondents submits that the order dated 22.01.2019 passed in CWP-7072-2018 has been complied with and necessary payment has been made to the petitioner.
4. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.

5. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
6. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-addressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
