1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing of FIR No.350 dated 27.11.2021 under Sections 498-A, 323, 406, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dera Bassi, District SAS Nagar (Mohali) (Annexure P-1) and all the subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom.
2. This Court, vide order dated 20.05.2024, directed the parties to appear before learned Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court on 26.07.2023 or any other date convenient to it or on the request of the parties, for getting their statements recorded with regard to compromise and it was made clear that no further

adjournment shall be granted to the parties for that purpose and report of learned Illaqa/Duty Magistrate was called for 13.08.2024 and on that date, one more opportunity was sought to comply with the order dated 20.05.2024. In view of the prayer made, the parties were directed to appear before the jurisdictional/Illaqa Magistrate within a period of two weeks in terms of the order dated 20.05.2024, subject to costs of Rs.5,000/- to be deposited with Poor Patients Welfare Fund, PGIMER, Chandigarh.

3. Report dated 07.09.2024 of learned learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Dera Bassi has been received and perusal of the same reveals that the parties did not appear before the Court for recording their statements regarding compromise within the stipulated time.

4. The case has been called twice since morning and despite that there is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that neither the petitioner nor his counsel is interested in pursuing the present revision petition.

5. In view of the above, having left with no other option, present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution.
