1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of DDR No.25 dated 10.11.2020 registered under Sections 323, 324, 279, 148, 149 of IPC at Police Station Division No.6 arising out of FIR No.280 dated 09.11.2020 registered under Sections 341, 323, 354, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC at Police Station Division No.6, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana (Annexure P-2) along with all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise deed dated 09.08.2023 (Annexure P-3).
2. A perusal of the report of the jurisdictional Court indicates that the injured witness, namely, Harpreet Singh i.e. respondent No.5 has not appeared to record his statement in terms of the compromise. As such, it has been reported that in the absence of all concerned persons, statements of the parties could not be recorded.

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3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.4 and 5 submits that the compromise between the parties has failed as respondent No.5 is not ready for the compromise and he is not coming forward to furnish his consent.
4. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners wishes to withdraw the present petition and seeks liberty to file a fresh petition in case, a genuine compromise is effected between the parties in future.
5. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
