This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act read with Article 215 of the Constitution of India for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobeying the order dated 16.12.2020 passed in CWP-21689-2020.

Learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that the petitioner has not been dispossessed of the property in question so far. Therefore, there is no contempt qua the order dated 16.12.2020 passed by this Court. He has further submitted that the respondents had only served a notice to the petitioner, however, the process has been stopped at that stage only; without proceedings any further.

In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left un-redressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
