The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in a case bearing FIR No.90 dated 13.02.2024 under Section 21(b) of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar Gurugram, District Gurugram.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 15.04.2024 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The reply dated 30.04.2024 filed on behalf of the respondent-State is taken on record.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 15.04.2024 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 15.04.2024 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands disposed of.
